The ensembles include: two concert choirs, a women's jazz ensemble, a women's a cappella group, a men's a cappella group, an elite small mixed chamber ensemble; a mixed show choir, Spotlight, and a women's show choir, Rhapsody. Her choirs have received consistent superior ratings in musicianship and performance since the establishment of the program. Her show choirs have received awards for vocal quality, choreography, and show design as well as numerous grand championships and placement trophies in Virginia, West Virginia, Illinois, Ohio, and Massachusetts.
