During competition season, he cohosts "Show Choir Live" on Sunday nights. Alex is also the creator of the show choir blocking app, StageBook for iPad, which is available now in the app store.

Heather Andre A native of Richmond, Virginia, Heather Glynn Andre began her career in music education when she opened the Cosby High School choral program in the fall of 2006. Under her direction, the program has grown to accommodate approximately 240 students in eight choirs under two choral directors. The ensembles include: two concert choirs, a women's jazz ensemble, a women's a cappella group, a men's a cappella group, an elite small mixed chamber ensemble; a mixed show choir, Spotlight, and a women's show choir, Rhapsody. Her choirs have received consistent superior ratings in musicianship and performance since the establishment of the program. Her show choirs have received awards for vocal quality, choreography, and show design as well as numerous grand championships and placement trophies in Virginia, West Virginia, Illinois, Ohio, and Massachusetts. Mrs. Rago now enjoys time with her husband, Carl, RV-ing across the states while continuing to contribute to the national and local choral scenes as clinician and adjudicator.

**Glenn Carlos** is the conductor of the Metropolitan Master Chorale and Assistant Professor of Music and Director of Choral Activities at Los Angeles Valley College. Professor Carlos has also held teaching and conducting posts at the University of Southern California and California State University, Long Beach. He is a consultant for the Grammy Awards Foundation and is a published choral composer and arranger. Throughout his more than 30 years of conducting, performing, teaching and studio work, Glenn has demonstrated his expertise in and love for vastly diverse musical genres.
