Alex Hall is a singer, songwriter and choreographer based in Los Angeles. He is a proud alumnus of DeKalb "Classic Connection" show choir in Indiana. He choreographs and writes original music for several award-winning show choirs from all corners of the country, and in 2013 was the recipient of the FAME Aspire Award for Best New Choreographer. During competition season, he co-hosts "Show Choir Live" on Sunday nights. Alex is also the creator of the show choir blocking app, StageBook for iPad, which is available now in the app store.

Heather Andre A native of Richmond, Virginia, Heather Glynn Andre began her career in music education when she opened the Cosby High School choral program in the fall of 2006. Under her direction, the program has grown to accommodate approximately 240 students in eight choirs under two choral directors. The ensembles include: two concert choirs, a women's jazz ensemble, a women's a cappella group, a men's a cappella group, an elite small mixed chamber ensemble; a mixed show choir, Spotlight, and a women's show choir, Rhapsody. Her choirs have received consistent superior ratings in musicianship and performance since the establishment of the program. Her show choirs have received awards for vocal quality, choreography, and show design as well as numerous grand championships and placement trophies in Virginia, West Virginia, Illinois, Ohio, and Massachusetts. She is grateful to be surrounded by such a fantastic team of colleagues, including dear friend and choreographer, Jason Peace and mentor, Peggy Ripley; boosters, and students who make the Cosby Choral Department an environment which fosters young singers to go above and beyond in performance, musicianship, and sportsmanship.

Mrs. Andre holds a Bachelor of Music Education with a concentration in voice from James Madison University in Harrisonburg, Virginia. She inherited her lifelong passion for teaching choral music from her beautiful mother, who is an elementary music teacher and featured soprano soloist in the Richmond area. Mrs. Andre currently resides in Moseley, Virginia with her husband Jeff and six-year old daughter, Madelyn. Mrs. Andre is thrilled to be a part of the Burroughs Music Showcase, and she looks forward to a wonderful weekend of outstanding performances!

Shane Coe is a freelance choreographer, adjudicator and clinician based in Columbus, Ohio. He graduated from Teays Valley High School where he was apart of the award winning "Prominent Rendition." Shane is a graduate of Bowling Green State University in Bowling Green, Ohio, where he received a Bachelor of Arts in Popular Culture and a minor in music. Shane also studied music education for four years while at BGSU. He currently choreographs for many show choirs across the country and has won many best choreography awards working with these groups. Shane has also choreographed for collegiate operas, musicals, A Cappella groups and barbershop choruses. He was a member of the BGSU Men's Chorus as well as a founding member of the Pop – A Cappella group, the HeeBeeBGs. While with the HeeBeeBGs, he helped the group with best choreography at ICCA. In his "free" time, Shane enjoys reading and hanging out with his dog, Wrigley.

Adam Peters is a freelance show choir clinician, show designer, collaborator, and adjudicator based out of Iowa City, IA. Over the last nine years, he has worked with numerous award winning show choirs across the country in clinic settings and has adjudicated competitions in California, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Missouri, Nebraska, South Dakota, and Texas. Adam is proud of his 6 years

spent as co-director of "River City Rhythm", the varsity show choir at Muscatine H.S. in Muscatine, IA where he created innovative award winning story/concept shows. In 2014, Adam was honored to receive the "Spirit of Service" ASPIRE award at the FAME National Championships in Chicago, IL.

Adam enjoys performing and most recently starred as "Sky Masterson" in New Era's "Guy & Dolls". He also has stepped behind the scenes stage managing The Green Room Theater's ground breaking production of "Angels In America" (Part 1 & 2) and also as the Northeast Tour Manager for the a cappella group "The Filharmonic". In his spare time, Adam enjoys running, yoga, following politics and storm chasing in Tornado Alley. In 2007, Adam performed "Amazing Grace" on The Oprah Winfrey Show. Every show choir season, Adam joins co-host Alex Hall for SHOW CHOIR LIVE - an online talk show (www.showchoirlive.com). Adam is proud of his decade of involvement every summer at Showchoir Camps of America and urges all to join in on the fun.

Randy Lanoue is the Artistic Director and Choreographer for the Twinsburg "Great Expectations". Groups that Randy has directed and choreographed have won numerous awards and competitions coast to coast, and recently celebrated their first disqualification. Randy is an Aries that enjoys nice long walks on the beach, shopping, and dogs.

Mary Rago For 28 years, Mary Rago was director of the Vocal Music Association at John Burroughs High School, Burbank, California. With an outstanding staff of musicians and choreographers, Mrs. Rago's choirs were regularly acclaimed for their excellence in both concert and show choir mediums, capturing grand championships and top honors in national and state show choir competitions as well as classical choir competitions and festivals. Prior to Burroughs, she taught choral music at John Muir Junior High School and Providence High School in Burbank, and in K-8 schools in Los Angeles and Chicago.

A native of Burbank, California, Mrs. Rago received the BA from Mundelein College, Chicago, Illinois; the MME from University of Notre Dame, South Bend, Indiana; and the MA from Claremont Graduate University, Claremont, California. She has been recognized with *Teacher of the Year Awards* from the Los Angeles County Music Educators and the Burbank Unified School District, *Woman of the Year* from the Burbank chapter of Zonta International, and as a finalist for the prestigious *Los Angeles Music Center Bravo Award*.

Mrs. Rago now enjoys time with her husband, Carl, RV-ing across the states while continuing to contribute to the national and local choral scenes as clinician and adjudicator.

Glenn Carlos is the conductor of the Metropolitan Master Chorale and Assistant Professor of Music and Director of Choral Activities at Los Angeles Valley College. Professor Carlos has also held teaching and conducting posts at the University of Southern California and California State University, Long Beach. He is a consultant for the Grammy Awards Foundation and is a published choral composer and arranger. Throughout his more than 30 years of conducting, performing, teaching and studio work, Glenn has demonstrated his expertise in and love for vastly diverse musical genres. He has been featured as a soloist with and prepared choirs for Quincy Jones, David Foster, Diane Warren, Michael Feinstein, Dave Brubeck, Barry Manilow and Shelly Berg. He is a member of the American Choral Directors Association and enjoys appearing as a guest clinician and adjudicator for choir festivals throughout Southern California.
