Heather Andre – (Friday Afternoon, Saturday All Sessions)

A native of Richmond, Virginia, Heather Glynn Andre began her career in music education when she opened the Cosby High School choral program in the fall of 2006. Under her direction, the program has grown to accommodate approximately 240 students in seven choirs under two choral directors. Her show choirs have received awards for vocal quality, choreography, and show design as well as numerous grand championships and placement trophies in Virginia, West Virginia, Illinois, Ohio, and Massachusetts. Mrs. Andre holds a Bachelor of Music Education with a concentration in voice from James Madison University in Harrisonburg, Virginia. She inherited her lifelong passion for teaching choral music from her beautiful mother, who is an elementary music teacher and featured soprano soloist in the Richmond area. Mrs. Andre currently resides in Moseley, Virginia with her husband Jeff and daughter, Madelyn.

Nick Prior – (Friday All Sessions, Saturday Morning & Evening)

Nicholas is a professional choral artist based in New York City, working as a singer, arranger, composer, adjudicator, panelist, and producer. He was named the Outstanding Music Education Graduate from the University of New Mexico, and earned his Masters Degree from Teachers College, Columbia University. He has conducted with the Brooklyn Youth Chorus, the Canticum Novum Singers, the Albuquerque Boy Choir, the UNM Children's Chorus, Suffolk County, and the 2019 NMMEA Elementary All-State Chorus.

Jen Oundjian – (Friday Evening, Saturday Afternoon)

Jen Oundjian has been choreographing and designing award-winning show choir, musical theatre productions and large event performances for three decades. She has been the resident Artistic Director and Choreographer for John Burroughs Powerhouse Showchoir for 25 years! Powerhouse has performed on The Voice, Dancing with the Stars, Ellen, America's Got Talent and The Oprah Winfrey Show. They have done high profile performances for dozens of Hollywood events and around the world performances including Hong Kong and Beijing. Her high-concept shows have taken Powerhouse to winning hundreds of first place achievements. Outside of show choir she produces groundbreaking immersive theatre productions in LA and is currently working on a brand-new musical Jimi Darkness. With a BFA from CalArts in costume design/theatre design, her shows consistently push the boundaries of creativity and passion. She works nationwide as a clinician, performance coach, and judge.

Randy Lanoue is a show choir costume designer from Cleveland, Ohio. Randy has designed costumes for premier show choirs from Boston to Los Angeles. Recently retired, Christine DeMore was the Vocal Music Director at David Starr Jordan Middle School in Burbank, CA. During her 21-year tenure her choirs were the highest ranked, award-winning Middle School in classical and show choir competitions in Southern California. She has served on the faculties of California Institute of the Arts in Valencia, California and as adjunct faculty in the Master of Arts in Teaching Program at the University of Southern California. In 2008 she was awarded the Los Angeles County Teacher of the Year Award, in 2013 the National Association for Music Educators Outstanding Educator Award for the Southern Section of California and in 2014 the Education Through Music- Los Angeles teacher of the year award. She is a graduate of Carnegie-Mellon University. Christine and her husband David lovingly have two children and with their husbands, four grandchildren.
