Under her direction, the program has grown to accommodate approximately 240 students in seven choirs under two choral directors. Her show choirs have received awards for vocal quality, choreography, and show design as well as numerous grand championships and placement trophies in Virginia, West Virginia, Illinois, Ohio, and Massachusetts. Mrs. Andre holds a Bachelor of Music Education with a concentration in voice from James Madison University in Harrisonburg, Virginia. She inherited her lifelong passion for teaching choral music from her beautiful mother, who is an elementary music teacher and featured soprano soloist in the Richmond area. Mrs. Andre currently resides in Moseley, Virginia with her daughter, Madelyn.

Jen Oundjian has been choreographing and designing award-winning show choir, musical theatre productions and large event performances for three decades. Powerhouse has performed on The Voice, Dancing with the Stars, Ellen, America's Got Talent and The Oprah Winfrey Show. Her high-concept shows have taken Powerhouse to winning hundreds of first place achievements. During her 21-year tenure her choirs were the highest ranked, award-winning Middle School in classical and show choir competitions in Southern California. She has served on the faculties of California Institute of the Arts in Valencia, California and as adjunct faculty in the Master of Arts in Teaching Program at the University of Southern California. In 2008 she was awarded the Los Angeles County Teacher of the Year Award, in 2013 the National Association for Music Educators Outstand Educator Award for the Southern Section of California and in 2014 the Education Through Music- Los Angeles teacher of the year award. She is a graduate of Carnegie-Mellon University. Christine and her husband David lovingly have two children and with their husbands, four grandchildren.

Glenn Carlos – (Saturday Evening)

Glenn Carlos is fascinated equally by classical and popular music! In addition to being the Artistic Director and conductor of the Metropolitan Master Chorale, he is a Professor of Music at Los Angeles Valley College where he serves as Director of Choral Activities. Before his tenure at LAVC, he held teaching and conducting posts at the University of Southern California, California State University, Long Beach, Pasadena City College, and Wayne State University. Glenn is a consultant for the Grammy Awards Foundation and the Grammy Museum, a published choral composer and arranger, and writes commissioned choral arrangements from choirs across the United States. Professor Carlos has been featured as a soloist and prepared choirs for Quincy Jones, David Foster, Diane Warren, Dru Hill, Taylor Dayne, Michael Feinstein, Dave Brubeck, Louie Bellson, Marvin Stamm, Shelly Berg and other musical luminaries. He is a member of the American Choral Directors Association and enjoys appearing as a guest clinician and adjudicator for choir festivals in Southern California.

Jini Scoville – (Solo Competition)

Jini has been a Lead Production Vocalist for 5 different cruise lines. While with Regent Seven Seas, she held the role of 'Emcee' in the showgirl spectacular Paradis, choreographed by Patti Wilcox.
